Dear Parents/ Carers, as a school we would like to share with you some information about an area of the curriculum we are developing ... 'The DCF' or the 'Digital Competence Framework..'

We see **Digital Competence** as a set of **knowledge, skills and attitudes** to enable our young people attending Ysgol Tir Morfa to **use technologies confidently, safely and creatively** in an increasingly digital world.

The **Digital Competence Framework** is the first element of the new curriculum for Wales.

The **Digital Competence Framework** is designed to be used across all curriculum areas. For example, if your child is working in an English lesson they may also be practising their digital skills.



The Digital Competence Framework is made up of 4 strands.
Each strand is split into a number of elements as shown below:




1. Citizenship	2. Interacting and collaborating	3. Producing	4. Data and computational thinking
