Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to a new school year. Our first week back has been a calm and positive one. It has been wonderful seeing our pupils return to full time education.

As you are aware, there are some additional health and safety aspects that we are bound to follow in line with advice from Welsh Government and Public Health Wales.

You may have seen in the news that the number of COVID-19 cases are increasing in some parts of Wales. It is vitally important that we do not let our guard down and forget the key virus control messages.

Please keep your child off school if they, or any member of your family, have ONE or more of the following symptoms:

- A new continuous cough
- A high temperature (37.8 degrees or over)
- Loss of, or change to, sense of smell or taste

If anyone has any of these symptoms please apply for a test by calling 119 between the hours of 7am – 11pm. If you have hearing or speech difficulties please call 18001119 to book your test.

Anyone with any of the above symptoms, or a positive test result, must isolate for 10 days and all other household members must isolate for 14 days.

All school meals must be paid for via parent pay. If this presents any difficulties then please contact us. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, this will need to be paid for until 11.9.2020 and then our usual system will apply.

Our door is always open if you have any concerns or need further support.

Please keep safe and well as we move forward with the Autumn term.
