Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Plans to reopen school fully from Thursday 3rd September 2020

I hope you are well in these unusual times. Having the school open for the last three weeks has enabled us to fine tune our risk assessment in preparation for full opening in September. Pupils and staff alike have enjoyed this time together to catch up and touch base.

Now we have received the full guidance from the Welsh Government we are in a position to open to all pupils as of the 3 September 2020 on a full-time basis.

Whilst the current situation continues, school uniform will not be compulsory. We will review this at October half term following any additional guidance from the Welsh government.

School dinners will be provided as normal but will be delivered to classes to reduce the number of contacts any child has in the school day.

We will continue to operate within defined bubbles to enable track and trace should the need arise.

The curriculum will be affected in some respects with subjects such as Physical Education as we are unable to facilitate changing on either site. We will endeavour to offer as broad and balanced a curriculum as possible during this time.

Pupils eligible for school transport will be contacted directly by the transport department to confirm arrangements for September.

I have attached our updated risk assessment and should you have any concerns please contact me.
